

## MEDLOCK PRIMARY SCHOOL

### In Autumn Term 2 Nursery 2 will be learning about “Families/Christmas”

#### Communication, Language, Literacy

We will be extending our vocabulary by learning and talking about ourselves, our families and our friends.

We will be modeling and extending the children’s communication skills when they are exploring the nursery environment. We use ‘Planning in the Moment’ to support children’s interests and extend their communication skills. This approach supports children in developing skills in listening, understanding and speaking.

#### Literacy Development

We will be practicing using our listening skills to listen to stories based on families and repeat familiar phrases and begin to retell stories e.g. ‘The wolf blew down the house of straw’. We will continue to post questions daily for our stories for pleasure. We will begin to record weekly stories and post them on seesaw to share at home.

#### Mathematical Development.

We will revisit all shapes to test our understanding and knowledge. We will be learning about the numbers 1-5, developing our knowledge of 1:1 counting, counting out groups of objects, representing numbers and identifying numerals.

#### Understanding the World

We will be talking about our families, friends, home experiences and special times. We will continue to notice changes in the season and discover signs of winter. We will take part in celebrations and traditions based on Christmas and Hanukkah.

#### Expressive art and Design

We will be accessing and using creative resources more independently and with a purpose. We will be learning new songs and rhymes and beginning to act out stories and familiar roles in the home corners and environment.

#### Physical Development

We will continue with our sports sessions with City in the Community, we will be learning basic skills such as running, skipping, balancing and using sports equipment like balls and hoops. In the outdoor area we will be running, skipping, climbing, using bikes, using small equipment, negotiating space and completing obstacle courses.

#### Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be developing more confidence in taking part in all aspects of the nursery routines. We will be building upon the friendships we have made and begin to share and build upon play ideas.
